Procedures.

- We will continue using Pickup Patrol instead of paper notes for dismissal changes this year. Pickup Patrol can be used on both a computer and an app. If you are picking up your child from school or have to change the way your child goes home, it must be entered in Pickup Patrol by 10:30 AM each day. Paper notes for dismissal will not be accepted. Information on registering your family on Pickup Patrol will be sent via email soon.
- All students will arrive at school through the back parking lot. Both buses and cars will drop off students here. The gates to the parking lot and rear doors to the school will close at 7:53.
 - Please enter the parking lot through the entrance closest to the convent, drive towards the red barn, and around to the entry doors.
- Please do not get out of your car. This is a "kiss and go" drop-off. Faculty and staff will be there to help your child if they need any assistance getting out of the car.
- At dismissal time, all parents who pick up their child/children must park in the St. John's Church parking lot and walk to the main entrance. Parking on St. John's Place is not permitted.

Uniform Policy.

Students need to be in complete formal uniforms for class and gym. Sweaters, blazers, sweatpants, and sweatshirts need the OLQA logo to be official which are only available through school sanctioned vendors (presently Flynn O'Hara). Violations of the uniform code will be recorded, and a referral slip will be sent home. Frequent violations of the uniform policy will result in afterschool detention. Changes the school has made to the uniform will have a one-year phase out time period.

Girl's Regulations: Jewelry should be limited to one simple necklace, one bracelet, and/or one simple pair of earrings that may be worn on the earlobe. Large necklaces (Puka shells, etc.) are not permitted. It is inappropriate to wear large dangling earrings, sweatbands, kerchiefs, body art, body piercing. Faddish and trendy hairstyles are not permitted. Girl's hair must be their God given color and any hairstyle that either distracts or attracts attention is not permitted. Unacceptable styles include: shaved, buzzed, sculptured, spiked and unnatural hair colors. Only headbands provided by Flynn O'Hara may be worn. No other headbands or bows are permitted. Nail polish must be clear or a pale pastel over their own natural nail. Nail art, fancy nails, French manicures, artificial nails and dark colors, such as black are not allowed. Temporary tattoos are not to be visible.

Boy's Regulations: Boy's hairstyles must be appropriate for the school setting. The hair length must be off the collar, above the ears, and out of the eyes of the student. Faddish and trendy hairstyles are not permitted. A boy's hair must be his natural **God given color**. The following hairstyles are not permitted: unbalanced, shaved, buzzed below level 1, tails, Mohawks, sculptured cuts, severe spikes, and hair length that is below the ear. No body piercing/earrings are permitted. Temporary tattoos are not to be visible.

GIRLS:

Skirt: Plaid uniform jumper (K-5)

Gray box pleated skirt (6-8)

Skort: Navy Skort

(worn only between 5/15 & 10/15)

Pants: Navy dress slacks (K-5 only in extreme

weather conditions)

Sweater: Navy with emblem

Blazer: Navy Blazer with emblem (6-8 only)

*Varsity Sweater with white shirt

(6-8 only)

Short or Long-Sleeved Solid Shirts:

White dress shirt w/ peter-pan

K-5th grade-Lt. Blue Polo w/school name or logo

6-8th Grade-Grey Polo w/school name or logo(worn only between

5/15 & 10/15)

Misc: Black school shoes

Blue knee-high socks or tights (no ankle socks)

Only the OLQA headband may be worn. Bows are not acceptable.

All:

- <u>Shoes:</u> Students are required to wear safe and supportive shoes. No flip flops, high heels, ballet slippers, chunky heels, crocs, or slipper type. **Boots of any type are not to be worn during school hours.** Sneakers may only be worn on gym day.
- Turtlenecks may be worn under the uniform shirt for warmth during the winter months.
- When the regular school uniform is worn, the school sweater may be worn over it. The school sweatshirt may only be worn over the gym uniform on gym days.
- Multiple layers should not be visible.
- School t-shirts with signatures or writing on them are not permitted on gym days.
- Hats or hoods may not be worn any time or any place in the school building.
- All uniforms must be properly maintained and worn appropriately. Torn, ripped or worn out blazers, pants and shirts MUST BE repaired or replaced at the request of the Administration.
- Students on sports teams may wear their team jersey in place of their sweater or blazer on game days. It is to be worn over the regular uniform.

Gym Uniform.

Either the navy sweat suit or navy shorts (during summer uniform time period) and school gym t-shirt with the school's logo on them are to be worn by students. (Students may wear other OLQA shirts – Field Day, End of Summer shirt, etc. for Gym Class. SHIRTS WITH SIGNATURES OR WRITING ON THEM ARE NOT PERMITTED TO BE WORN ON GYM DAYS) All are available through the Flynn and O'Hara Uniform Company. Sneakers are to be worn with Gym Uniform only. Sweatpants are not to be worn as shorts. Multiple layers are not to be visible.
